#### **Getting Started in a Small Group Process**

Recommended size: 3-5 people, so everyone can speak.

Always begin with a generous supply of 'hospitality'.

- 1. Opening Prayer. Our Father
- 2. <u>Check-In</u>. How have you noticed Christ's presence in your daily life, since the last meeting? Give concrete examples and incidents.
- 3. <u>Lectio Divina</u> on Gospel Readings. Using the Gospel reading from the upcoming Sunday Mass (see calendar of readings here <a href="http://www.usccb.org">http://www.usccb.org</a>), practice the lectio divine as outlined below.
- 4. <u>Spiritual Formation Piece</u>. This is open-ended, to be determined by you all. There are plenty of materials that are out there, such as those listed on our website's Small Groups page. Keep the focus on materials that a geared towards living discipleship in Christ and building a relationship with Him.

Regardless of the material you choose, spend 15-20 minutes reading/watching key information, as a group.

- 5. Reflection on the Material. Once you are done going through the material, discuss:
  - a. What stood out for you from this material? Why?
  - b. What questions does this material raise for you? Why?
  - c. How does this material help/challenge you to live out your discipleship in Christ on a deeper level?
- 6. Prayer Intentions. Spend some time allowing people to voice their intentions.
- 7. <u>Decade of the Rosary</u>. Finish with One Our Father, Ten Hail Mary's, and Glory Be.

Continue with a generous supply of 'hospitality'!!

## LECTIO DIVINA Shared in Community Listening for the Gentle Touch of Christ the Word

(The Literal Sense)

- **I.** One person reads aloud (twice) the passage of scripture, as others are attentive to some segment that is especially meaningful to them.
- 2. Silence for I-2 minutes. Each hears and silently repeats a word or phrase that attracts.
- **3.** Sharing aloud: [A word or phrase that has attracted each person]. A simple statement of one or a few words. **No elaboration**.

#### How Christ the Word speaks to ME

(The Allegorical Sense)

- **4.** Second reading of same passage by another person.
- **5. Silence** for 2-3 minutes. Reflect on "Where does the content of this reading touch my life today?"
- 6. Sharing aloud: **Briefly**: "I hear, I see..."

#### What Christ the Word Invites me to DO

(The Moral Sense)

- **7.** Third reading by still another person.
- **8. Silence** for 2-3 minutes. Reflect on "I believe that God wants me to . . . . . today/this week."
- **9.** Sharing aloud: at somewhat greater length the results of each one's reflection. [Be especially aware of what is shared by the person to your right.]
- 10. After full sharing, pray for the person to your right.

Note: Anyone may "pass" at any time. If instead of sharing with the group you prefer to pray silently, simply state this aloud and conclude your silent prayer with Amen.
